>> Keep an eye out for the **Sports Museum of America**, set to open in New York City this spring. Billed as "the nation's first museum dedicated to all sports," it will be the new home of the Heisman Trophy and its annual TV presentation as well as the first Women's Sports Hall of Fame. The interactive, multimedia exhibits will feature memorabilia, artifacts, stories and displays on sports heroes, fans and teams. It will also house the Billie Jean King International Women's Sports Center. Sports partners include the College Football Hall of Fame, Hockey Hall of Fame, International Boxing Hall of Fame, International Tennis Hall of Fame, International Swimming Hall of Fame and others.
